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### THE TAX ADVANTAGES OF EMPLOYING YOUR SPOUSE

There are many benefits if your business qualifies for spousal employment.

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You may not be thinking of taxes right now, but you should be—especially if your business operates as a sole proprietorship and qualifies for spousal employment. By formally employing your spouse in the business this year, you could reap several tax benefits.

#### **Health Care**

The most significant benefit you could receive is that you could deduct 100% of your health care expenses.

By formally employing your spouse and establishing an Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 105 medical reimbursement plan, you, as a qualifying sole proprietor, may deduct these health care costs.

If you file a file a Schedule C or a Schedule F form and you establish the plan, you may be able to deduct 100% of your medical, dental and vision insurance premiums. In addition, 100% of your out-of-pocket expenses not covered by insurance can be covered under the plan. Typically, qualifying small business owners save between \$1,000 and \$2,000 off their yearly tax bill.

#### **IRA Deduction**

A second benefit of a formal employment relationship between spouses is the IRA deduction. A spouse-employee can create an IRA account in which the spouse can contribute up to \$2,000 per year. The contribution can be tax deductible by the employee or it could be invested in a Roth IRA which is not deductible but on which the earnings may never be taxed. This can be an important aspect of retirement planning for the employee and family.

#### **Social Security**

The third tax benefit of this relationship is that it allows the spouse to establish his or her own Social Security account. Again, this may assist with retirement planning; however, and more importantly, it is a source of income in the event of a disability and it establishes eligibility for Medicare.

#### **Expenses**

Finally, if your spouse were to become a bonafide employee in your sole proprietorship, you would be able to deduct any ordinary and necessary spousal business travel and entertainment. This can be a significant benefit for many types of businesses.
